FINANCIAL AID

START WITH THE FAFSA

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be filled out each year to apply for financial aid and many scholarships. While it is best to file by April 1st (our priority filing date), if you miss that date, it is not too late - aid is still available.



FILLING OUT THE FAFSA

- File your FAFSA at studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa
- Apply for a FAFSA FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov

You'll need a number of things to file your FAFSA, like your social security number and a driver's license (if any). If you earned income in the last two years you will need your prior-prior year's W-2 forms and your prior-prior year's Federal Income Tax Return (and your spouse, if you are married): IRS Form 1040 or foreign tax return. You'll also need your parent's income information, so have their prior-prior year Federal Income Tax Return (if you are a dependent student as defined by the FAFSA).

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

GIFT AID: Gift aid is free money - money that does not have to be repaid.

- GRANTS: Typically grants are need-based but some have a merit component.
- SCHOLARSHIPS: Typically merit-based and can come from a variety of sources including the University, campus departments, private and nonprofit organizations.
- TRIBAL AID: Scholarships and grant funds for Native American students.

 SELF-HELP AID: Self-Help aid is aid that requires a commitment on the part of the student or parent to either repay funds received and/or work to earn income that helps cover the cost of education.
- FEDERAL WORK-STUDY: Need-based federal financial aid program that
 provides funds for part-time job opportunities to undergraduate and graduate
 students.
- LOANS: There are several types of loans available to students and parents of dependent undergraduate students. For more information about both the federal and the private loan program, visit financialaid.arizona.edu/types-of-aid/loans

MERIT TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS

At Arizona, we love to reward students for their hard work and commitment to education. If you completed your application by May 1st, we'll automatically consider you for merit scholarships. Awards are based on your core unweighted high school GPA through your sixth semester.



WILDCAT TUITION AWARD: Awarded to incoming Arizona residents.

ARIZONA TUITION AWARD: Awarded to incoming non-Arizona residents.

NATIONAL SCHOLARS AWARD: Awarded to both incoming in-state and out-of-state National Scholars Finalists
