Important Information and Definitions

Who should submit this form?

Complete this form if you indicated on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) that you are either an unaccompanied youth who is homeless or are an unaccompanied youth providing for your own living expenses who is at risk of being homeless. If you did not indicate either of these situations on the FAFSA but believe you meet the requirements to be considered an unaccompanied youth at risk of homeless based on the definitions below, then you can submit this form. If the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid requires additional information, we may contact you or those you indicate on the form or in supporting documentation to verify your circumstances.

Unaccompanied – not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.

Homeless –lacking fixed, regular, and adequate housing, which includes living in shelters, cars, hotels/motels, or temporarily living with others because not other options were available.

At risk of being homeless— when housing may cease to be fixed, regular, and adequate, for example, a student who is being evicted and has been unable to find fixed, regular, and adequate housing.

Youth – means you are 23 years of age or younger or you are still enrolled in high school as of the day you sign your FAFSA

Who should complete section A of this form?

A McKinney-Vento liaison, director of a HUD-funded shelter, or the director of an RHYA-funded shelter should complete section A. If you are unable to obtain verification from one of the three authorized agents in Section A, then proceed to section B.

Who are McKinney-Vento Liaisons?

Under subtitle VII-B of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, every school district is required to designate a liaison for students experiencing homelessness. Homeless liaisons have a number of legal responsibilities under the Act, including identifying youth who meet the definition of homeless and are unaccompanied.
